

BOOTH & EVENTS SELLING: BEST PRACTICES

Before you set up your booth, read though these tips that can help you achieve the best and most profitable results.

- 1. Purchase or hire a sturdy trestle table or similar table that fits within the events required space.
- 2. Drape the table with clean white (or black) fabric from your local fabric store (keep it simple: avoid patterns, which will distract from the product itself).
- 3. Arrange your product and display the posters and other sales material attractively. You can also purchase plastic display stands to highlight a certain product, but use them sparingly. Pull up banners for each product can also be purchased or rented. See Booth & Events section on Amway's website under "Resources" tab.
- 4. Avoid clutter and don't try to present too much. You can keep extra product in boxes underneath the table for easy access.
- 5. If you use props (such as flowers, etc.) remember that less is more. The props should be a support element for the product and not overwhelm the presentation.
- 6. Focus on one brand. If you're displaying more than one product, for example NUTRIWAY® and XS®, make sure that one brand is the "hero" of the booth.
- 7. Make sure you have enough product on hand for the event but be conservative. Instead of buying a lot of full-size product, use samples whenever possible. If your customers can try something on the spot, or even later, they're more likely contact you for a sale. Sample XS in small cups, cut up Positrim Protein Bars® and use ARTISTRY® samplers. (Bring along a cooler to keep XS drinks cold) When handling food it is important to consider hygiene; make sure you use gloves and tongs, plus be very careful with storage.
- 8. Have plenty of order forms and business cards on hand plus have a notepad and pen to take customer details should they wish to be contacted after the event.
- 9. Dress appropriately for the event. Remember, you're representing your business and the product brand so you want to make a professional impression. Logo gear would be appropriate to wear.
- Make sure you display the authorisation certificate provided by Amway in a prominent place, that way other IBOs will know Amway has granted authorisation.
